Penetrating the Obstacle Limitation Surface of LHBP airport due to activated crane garden next to Terminal 2 areas

1. GENERAL

The objective of this AIP-SUP is to inform the relevant personnel about the penetration of obstacle limitation surfaces of LHBP airport by cranes erected next to the RWY 13L/31R.

- Declare the penetration of surfaces.
- Determine the position and radius of crane garden with height of crane.
- Declare the obstacle markings and signs, and procedures.

2. BACKGROUND

The construction of ASC and KÖF buildings next to the airport has been started.

During the construction period a crane garden is activated. The number of cranes is between 1 and 5 depends on the status of construction.

3. PERIOD OF CRANE GARDEN

The crane garden is active:

From: **05:00 5th of October 2026**

To: **15:00 31st of May 2027**

Operational period: **H24**

4. POSITION OF CRANE GARDEN AND HEIGHT

The coordinates of the centre position of the crane garden are: **47°25'46.80" N 019°16'05.91" E**

The radius of the crane garden is: **120 m** from the centre position.

Top elevation of the highest crane is: **169 m AMSL.**

5. OBSTACLE MARKINGS, LIGHTS AND PROCEDURES

Due to height of cranes the airport obstacle limitations surfaces are not penetrated, but there is no other obstacle close to the cranes!

All relevant cranes are marked by red and white strips and lighted by low/medium intensity red obstacle lights according to ICAO ANNEX 14.
